



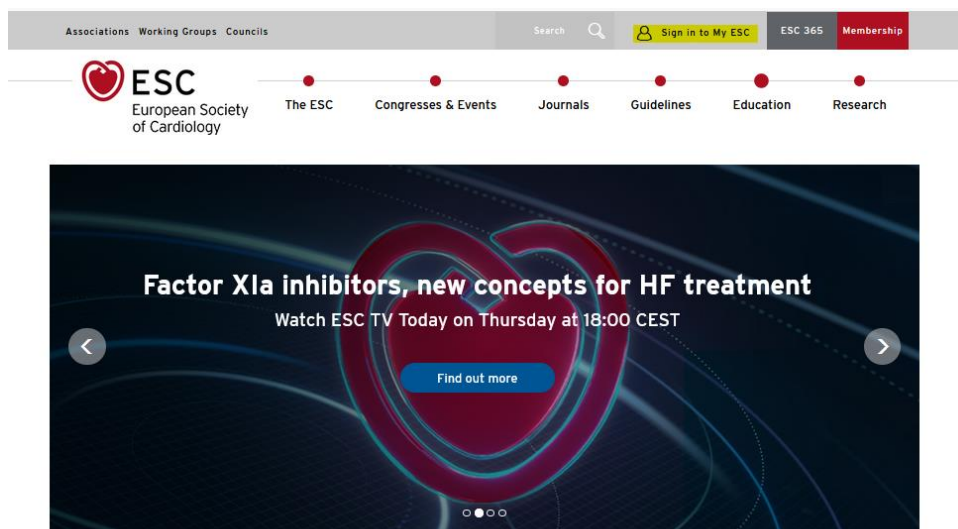



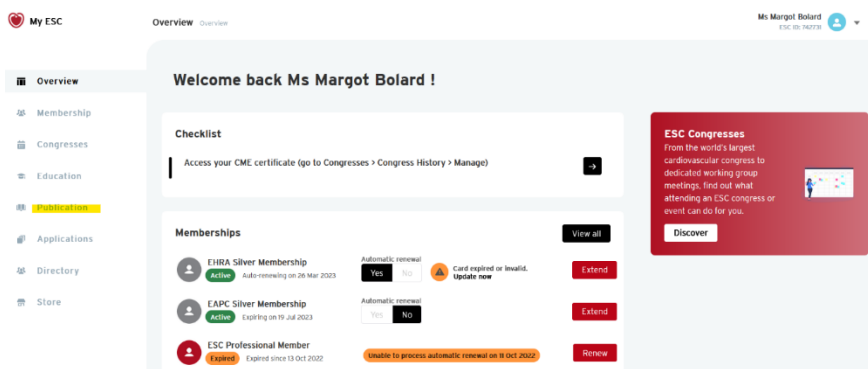

EHJ features original papers, reviews, clinical perspectives, ESC Clinical Practice Guidelines and articles about recent developments.

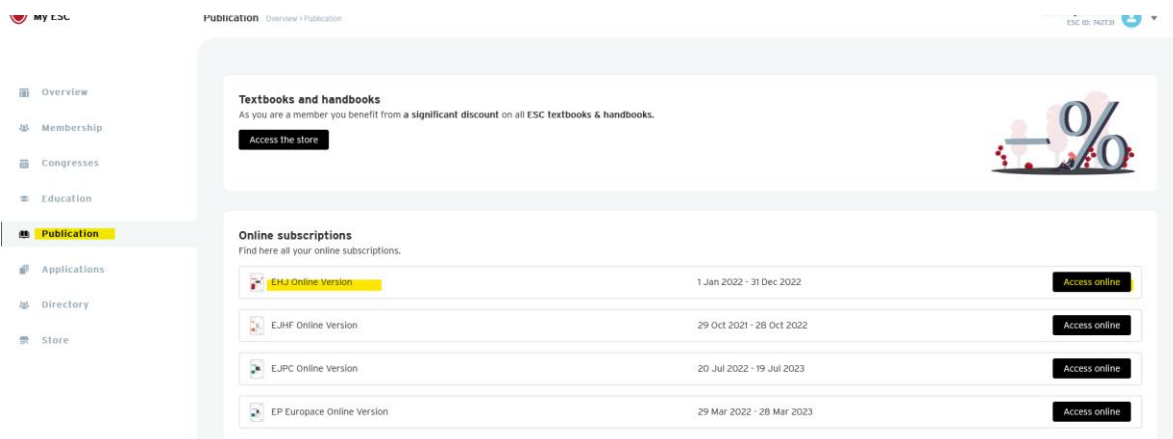
