From these two documents two webinars will be funded and disseminated

- 3) As Liaison Officer I am contributing to arrange the firs CCP meeting: since I have begun this activity I would like to follow its complete realization

My name is Stefano Nistri.

I was born in Rome, took my Degree in Medicine at Florence University, and my Post Graduate in Cardiology at Padua University. I completed my PhD in Experimental and Applied Internal Medicine in Florence.

I live in Padua and carry my clinical activity exclusively in an outpatient setting, accredited with the Italian National Health System, as Chief of the Cardiology Service of CMSR Veneto Medica (Altavilla Vicentina, Italy) and as consultant cardiologist in other outpatient facilities.

My main interests regards cardiovascular imaging focusing on echocardiography, particularly on standard echocardiography in primary-care setting. My

specific research interests are valvular heart disease (with focus on aortic stenosis, regurgitation and bicuspid aortic valve), hypertrophic cardiomyopathy and its phenocopies, left ventricular subclinical dysfunction with specific focus on diastolic dysfunctions, and definition and detection of abnormalities of thoracic aorta.

I have been a faculty member of multiple ESC and EACVI meetings

I am actually serving as Liaison Officer of the Council for Cardiology Practice. As Liaison Officer of the CCP, I co-authored "Late phase of COVID-19 pandemic in General Cardiology. A position paper of the ESC Council for Cardiology Practice" and arranged an ongoing educational program joint with EACVI, which should be completed in the next year. Moreover,
