

Elections to Council Nucleus and Nominating committee 2024-2026

Motivation letter: Why are you interested in joining the Council Nucleus or Nominating committee?

Over the past decade, Cardio-Oncology has become a rapidly evolving field of Cardiovascular Medicine and the European Society of Cardiology (ESC) undertook a leading role in this field through several initiatives. I had the chance to contribute to all important ESC initiatives in Cardio-Oncology, serving as the Chair of Heart Failure Association (HFA) Working Group on Cardio-Oncology, ex officio member of the Board of ESC Council of Cardio-Oncology, member of the Task Force for the 2022 ESC Guidelines on Cardio-Oncology and leading author for the 2023 ESC Core Curriculum for Cardio-Oncology, while participating in relevant ESC/HFA workshops and scientific documents and delivering relevant lectures in ESC congresses.

Being both the Chair of HFA Study Group on Cardio-Oncology and a board member of ESC Cardio-Oncology Council, I served as the liaison between the two entities, ensuring their close collaboration, that has hitherto been quite fruitful, as indicated by a series of scientific documents, the 2023 ESC Core Curriculum on Cardio-Oncology and other activities. My liaison role was further supported by my additional roles in ESC (past Chair of HFA Committee on Atrial Disease, member of HFA Certification Committee, member of taskforce of the 2021 and 2023 ESC Guidelines on heart failure, contributor to HFA position papers), my participation in International Cardio-Oncology Society Greek chapter and my academic appointments.

My plan as the ESC Cardio-Oncology Council's Liaison Officer in the case I am elected, is to reinforce the already established communication between the Council, the HFA and other ESC bodies, while promoting new forms of collaboration with other relevant European and international societies such as ESMO, EHA, ESTRO and IC-OS, and with the ESC member state national Cardio-Oncology societies. As Cardio-Oncology is by definition a multidisciplinary field, the role of the Liaison Officer is a key one. Bringing in the knowhow of all implicated stakeholders including healthcare professionals, patient organizations, academia and industry, will be crucial for preserving and strengthening further the leading role of ESC in this exciting new field.
