I am a specialist of three disciplines: internal medicine, cardiology and clinical oncology.

I work at the National Research Institute of Oncology in Warsaw which was founded by Maria Skłodowska-Curie (double Nobel Prize Laureate, she was born in Warsaw). I created Department of Cardio-Oncology at the Institute of Hematology and Transfusion Medicine in Warsaw.

I am Director of the Teaching Program in cardio-oncology at the Centre of Postgraduate Medical Education in Poland and Chair of Education and Training Committee of the International Cardio-Oncology Society (IC-OS).

My main idea is to significantly include hematologists and oncologists into cardio-oncology activities. That is why I became Chair of Supportive Care of the Polish Society of Clinical Oncology where I would see a strong place for cardio-oncology.

I have been working for the ESC as Ex-Officio Board Member of the Council of Cardio-Oncology since 2020. Now I am a lead of the Study Group on Thrombosis (one of the new 6 study groups).
