Motivation letter: What would you do if successfully elected? (250 words max)

Dear Colleagues,

After having spent two years in the Board as Education & Scientific Programme Coordinator, it is my pleasure to submit my application for Secretary/Scientific Documents Co-Lead.

I'm currently an Associate Professor in Internal and Geriatric Medicine, with a solid scientific experience about AF and, consequently, the primary and secondary prevention of stroke, as well as its clinical management, often complicated by the co-occurrence of other conditions. In my clinical work, I manage older old patients (often ≥80 years) with multimorbidity and frailty, very often with an history of stroke.

I am convinced that such clinical and scientific background has given me the right tools to assist the next Chief and the future Chief Elect of the Council, in the management of our valid and heterogenous group. Indeed, in the currently changing epidemiological background even our stroke patients are now different than the past and more and more clinically complex. Integrating the cardiologic and neurologic expertise, largely represented in the Council, with my internist and geriatric background would be a strong opportunity to further grow our Council.

Contemporary, serving in the Board and being part of its Scientific Documents Group, being involved in several documents, both led by the Council and in which the Council is a partner, I understood that putting my experience as a scientist to shape the future production of the Council would be the best way to help it to grow further in our scientific community.

For all these reasons, I think I will be adequate to cover the Secretary/Scientific Documents Co-Lead duties.
