Group 3. The role of new technologies in the collection and assessment of PED/PROs

- 1. Digital nurse (using AI) or Avatar to facilitate the survey
- 2. Use of smartphone to have patient report outcomes
- 3. We need reliable devices
- 4. Use of external devices removes the need to come to the hospital, time and money saving (ask preference of patient)
- 5. External devices to measure objective parameters such as movement
- 6. Physiological indices (continuous) monitoring will provide appropriate measure of daily life
- 7. Training of patients is needed (show them, peer support), which may cause bias, literacy may be issue
- 8. If you ask for patient's input, involve many patients
- 9. Design studies preferably based on the wearable device the patients already have (may be difficult from industry perspective)
- 10. Think about bias
