Alan Fraser is Consultant Cardiologist at the University Hospital of Wales, Cardiff, UK; Visiting Professor in Cardiovascular Imaging and Dynamics at the University of Leuven; and Emeritus Professor of Cardiology at the Wales Heart Research Institute, Cardiff University.

He qualified in Edinburgh, undertook postgraduate training in Scotland and Wales, and was research fellow at the Thoraxcentre in Rotterdam. He is a Past-President of the European Association of Cardiovascular Imaging, and past Chairman of the Committee on Regulatory Affairs of the European Society of Cardiology.

He chairs the Regulatory Affairs Committee of the Biomedical Alliance in Europe, and he is Scientific Director of the EU Horizon 2020 CORE-MD project (developing regulatory science for high-risk medical devices) which includes a project on the clinical evaluation of artificial intelligence software for medical devices. His research interests include cardiac imaging, heart valve disease, heart muscle disease, and the pathophysiology and diagnosis of heart failure.
