Professor Casado Arroyo studied medicine at the University of Cantabria in Spain. He trained in intensive care, cardiology and specifically in cardiac <u>electrophysiology.at</u> the Vrije Universiteit Brussels and the University of Pennsylvania. He is professor of Medicine at the Free University of Brussels and director of the Pacing and Electrophysiology Lab at the Brussels University Hospital.

He is a Past-President of the eCardiology Working group and co-chair of the EHRA Advocacy, Quality Improvement Committee and Health Economics. He is partner and scientific advisor of the ASSESS Digital Health Technology project. It is a project funded by the European Union that will increase the adoption of trustworthy and effective Digital Health Technologies (DHT) across Europe, enabling a more coherent digital single market, for health systems and patients to access DHTs from all over Europe and giving industry a European market. The main focus will be on developing robust and harmonising methodologies for Health Technology Assessment of DHT.
