



Prof. Tabassome Simon, France

Tabassome Simon is Professor of Medicine and Clinical Pharmacology in the Department of Pharmacology at Assistance Publique-Hôpitaux de Paris (St Antoine Hospital) and Sorbonne University, Paris, France. T. Simon is currently the Head of the Department and the director of the Clinical Research platform of East of Paris, that coordinates more than 90 multicenter national and international studies throughout France. She is also one of APHP's VP deputy for research at APHP.

In addition to teaching pharmacology for medical students, T. Simon is the Coordinator of Master Diploma of clinical research for physicians and scientists, and university diplomas for the formation of investigators, research assistants, technicians, and pharmacovigilants, as well as diploma for pharmacogenetics and personalized medicine in France.

She chairs currently the Clinical Trials Working Group (CTWG) of the European University Hospital Alliance (EUHA) that aims to foster collaboration amongst the 10 leading European university hospitals of EUHA, to set up and speed up the development of joint academic clinical trials.

Dr Simon was the first woman elected Chair of the European Association for Clinical Pharmacology and Therapeutics (EACPT). She has received several awards from the French Society of Cardiology, the French Society of Pharmacology, the French Society of Angiology, the EACPT and the EUPHAR.

Her primary research interests are pharmacological cardiovascular prevention, particularly in myocardial infarction. She is the scientific coordinator of several ongoing trials and studies in myocardial infarction. She has published more than 300 original articles in international peer-reviewed journals, including The New England Journal of Medicine, The Lancet, JAMA, Nature Med, Circulation, JACC, Eur Heart Journal, etc.
