Implementation science:

- Health literacy: awareness of science; fidelity; implementation GDMT more expensive (incentives (targets vs economics))
- Efficient models of implementation and introduction of medical innovations

Infrastructure investment

- Departmental budgets: need wider system overview
- Cost-effectiveness: current costs vs long-term benefits (hospitalizations, mortality, HCP visits)
 - Reimbursement to other sector of health (policy level rather than organizational level)
- Trial endpoints: more relevant to hospital/health costs
- Complex decision-making/prescribing rules: increase inefficiencies
- Influence of national societies: varied engagements between ESC and organisations
- Workforce: access to guidelines
