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ACCREDITATION AS RECOGNITION AND INCENTIVES FOR CENTERS

Group 1. Incentives for center to participate in a quality of care programme

General

- Is accreditation the right tool to improve quality of care ????
- Quality indicators
- What diseases to focus on?
 - Prevention of CV disease, quality measures for prevention, from intervention to prevention, both primary and secondary, primary care, early
 - Evidence gaps performance gaps in advanced health care systems for e.g. Lipids
- Include nurses and pharmacists to increase engagement
- Instead of quality indicators it may be necessary to improve care pathway

Incentives

- Money is the main driver, KPI's / quality indicators related to guideline implementation only work if there is financial stimulus, who gets paid
- Provide performance information back (data driven), also individual information
- Visibility of the center, reputation: More referral of patients, attract talent
- May be less interesting to patients
