ACCREDITATION AS RECOGNITION AND INCENTIVES FOR CENTERS

Group 2. Sustainability of accreditation overtime from the ESC & center perspectives

- **Link routine data collection to registries** (legal contract requirement)
- **Provide data on effectiveness:** demonstrate that participating centers perform better than non-participating centers
- **Collaboration industry – scientific societies** (infrastructure changes remain when priorities change, whilst staff might be hard to keep when priorities change). **Focus on local/geographic upgrade of infrastructure.**
- **Phase 4 of RCTs** – use this phase for implementation of new technologies and drugs

ACCREDITATION AS RECOGNITION AND INCENTIVES FOR CENTERS

Group 2. Sustainability of accreditation overtime from the ESC & center perspectives

- **Cultural change** – address the next generation to ensure sustainability
- **Benefits** for individuals participating in programmes of accreditations (certification, membership, etc)
- **Center-specific approach:** addressing the complexities of local, regional, and national organisations
- **Patient involvement:** is accreditation the way to implement the guidelines? Are the good and the great promoted to expand the gap with poorer performers?
