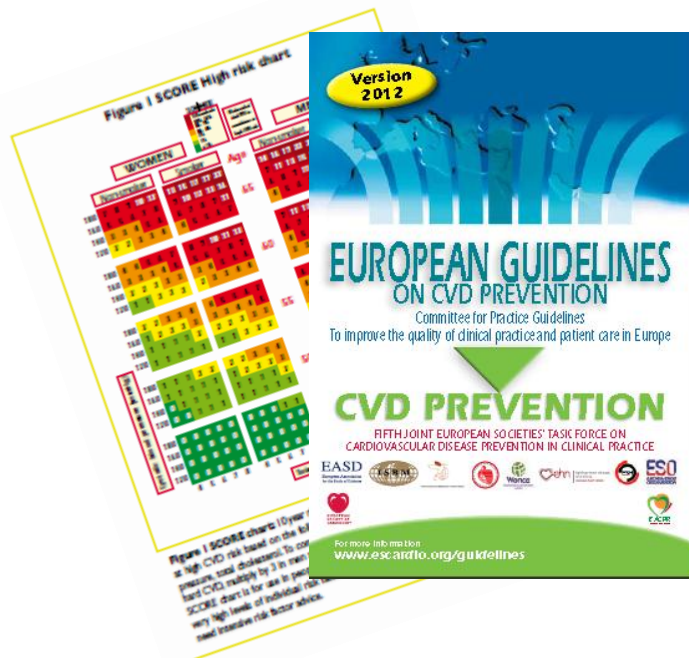

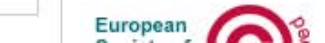

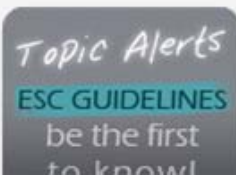

Four new guidelines were produced during 2011 and presented to the membership during the 2011 guidelines overview session.

The first presentation was jointly performed by Dr. Tendera (Poland) and Dr. Aboyans (France) who chaired the guideline on "diagnosis and treatment of peripheral artery diseases". For the first time, the ESC issued guidelines on this topic, documenting the atherosclerotic changes in the different vessel beds. The guideline includes diagnostic approaches and therapeutic options, and required an entire team of cardiologists, vascular surgeons, ~~neurologists, and specialists for its production~~

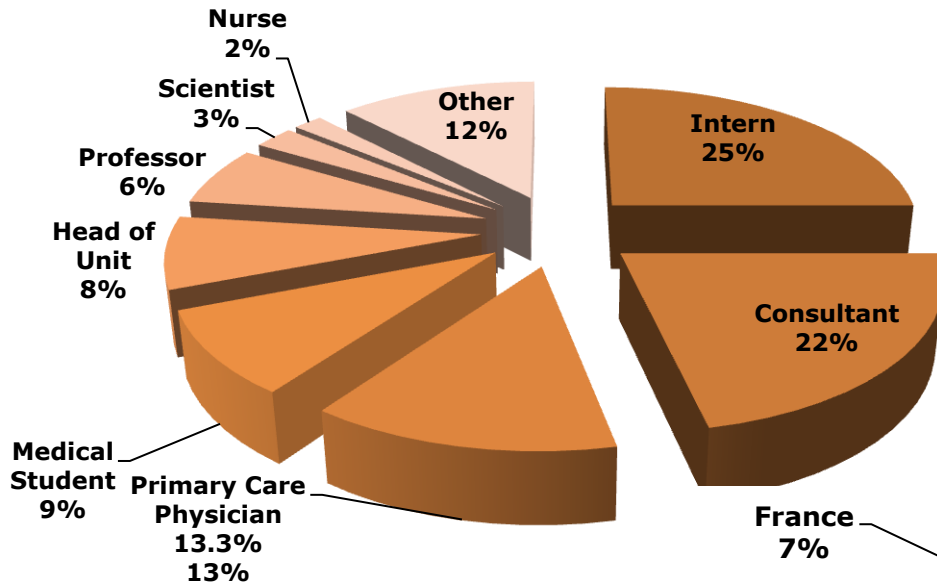

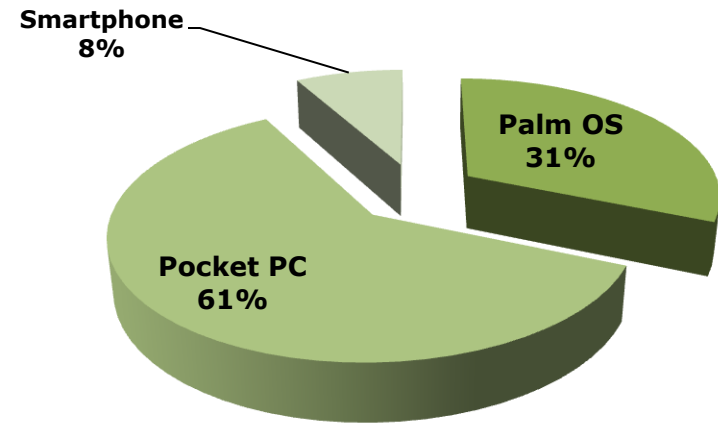
