Four new guidelines were produced during 2011 and presented to the membership during the 2011 guidelines overview session.

For the first time, the ESC issued guidelines on this topic, documenting the atherosclerotic changes in the different vessel beds. The guideline includes diagnostic approaches and therapeutic options, and required an entire team of cardiologists, vascular surgeons,

# Role of National Guidelines Coordinator

### Role of "National Topic Expert"

- Proposed by the NGC for a specific guideline
- Role in dissemination and implementation actions of guidelines in his/her area of expertise, in conjunction with the NGC, such as:
  - Participation in Guidelines Implementation
     Meetings organized for a specific guidelines at the EHH
  - Translation of pocket GL
  - Creation and/or translation of educational materials, such as essential messages, clinical cases, MCQs...
  - Scientific sessions during the national congresses with NGC and NS Board
  - Educational courses or educational webinars



### **Guideline meeting or Webinar?**

- Advantages of webinar
  - More efficient time management
  - No travel, hotel, catering expenses
  - Optimal use of e.based learning
- Potential disadvantage
  - Less face-to-face interaction, informal discussions, break-out sessions
- More suited for "focused" guidelines


