



EHRA ELECTIONS 2022 - CODE OF CONDUCT

This document describes the code of conduct to be respected by candidates for an elected voting position on the EHRA Board.

- 1) Candidates for elected positions at the EHRA Board should refrain from canvassing activities such as travelling to meet Constituent Bodies for reasons not related to their current ESC or EHRA activities, or from direct mailing / e-mailing to Constituent Bodies.
- 2) Board members of the EHRA, members of EHRA Nominating Committee and Past Presidents of the EHRA should not campaign for any candidate to elected Board positions.
- 3) Following the assignment of candidates by the EHRA Nominating Committee, the application forms of all retained candidates will be posted on the EHRA Elections page of the ESC website.
- 4) At the discretion of the Nominating Committee some additional documents (slide presentation, motivation letter, ...) of each candidate for the position of President-Elect can also be published on the Elections page of the ESC website
- 5) No other form of campaign activity is allowed during the election period, which starts with the official publication of the final slate to the end of the voting period.
- 6) In case of serious violation on the part of the candidate, the Nominating Committee or Ethics & Oversight Committee will examine the evidence and act accordingly.
