- 9. Finally, expand my role as role model: improving opportunities and visibility for (young) women within EHRA and within the ESC.

I really would be delighted if I could continue my work within EHRA, because I know how this association works and which challenges EHRA encounters, with the ESC and sister societies but also with partnerships with the industries. Therefore, I am sure that I will contribute to a further growth and visibility of EHRA!
