

## Public event / open clinic

- Three oral presentations on heart failure were presented for the public at the local department of the Danish Heart Foundation in the three largest cities of Denmark; Århus, Odense and Copenhagen as part of the Heart Failure Awareness Day, 2017.
- The events were taking place at;
  - Århus, May the 9<sup>th</sup>, 2017, from 4-6 pm by Brian Løgstrup, MD, PhD
  - Odense, May the 9<sup>th</sup>, 2017, from 4-6 pm by Mikael Kjær Poulsen, MD, PhD
  - Copenhagen, May the 17<sup>th</sup>, 2017 from 4-6 pm by Emil Wolsk, MD, PhD
- Each public event was fully booked with 60 participants at each site.
